



FLORIANI STABILISER ORGANISER

This organiser was made for seven rolls of similar size, you can add or delete as you wish. The pattern requirements will differ from these if you do.

MATERIALS

FLORIANI Stitch and Shape one side fusible 65 cm X 30cm

FLORIANI Heat N Sta Fusible fleece 70cm x 25cm

FLORIANI Heat N Sta Tearaway

FLORIANI Water Soluble Topping

FLORIANI Embroidery Threads (colours of choice)

Fabric for background 2 x 70cm x 33cm

Fabric for loops 2.15m x 30 cm

2 m fine piping or piping cord and fabric to make your own.

30cm cord for hanging

Construction thread

FLORIANI Pressing Cloth

METHOD

- At one end of Stitch N Shape trace around a small plate or circle template to round off the corners, cut along the line. Set aside.
- Measure 17 cm down from the top edge of the fabric strip for the loops and draw a line with a tailors chalk Do Not use water soluble pen.
- Rule another line 27.5cm down from the first line.
- Repeat last step 6 times.
- Press Heat N Stay Tearaway to the wrong side of the fabric 2.5 cm larger than your hoop behind these lines
- Embroider the names of the products along the top of these lines using Water Soluble Topper on surface of the fabric, centring the words across the width.
- On the very top edge (where we have our logo) you can embroider a design or leave plain if desired
- Tear away all the topper and tearaway from behind.
- Using the pressing cloth and a steam iron, press each embroidery and "steam through" the cloth to remove any stray ends of topper and to set embroidery. This may take a couple of shots of steam for each embroidery. Alternatively, wet a cotton tip and run it around the edge of each embroidery to dissolve stray ends.



- Turn in 1.5 cm twice on each long side of the finished strip. Stitch down.
- Turn under and press 2cm on bottom edge.
- Measure down 8cm from top edge and mark and again 22cm from the mark and fold up ,wrong sides together .Stitch from one side to the other to form a loop .Measure 6cm from the stitching and repeat until you have 7 loops with a 6cm gap between each and a piece at the end .Set aside.
- Press fusible fleece to wrong side of one backing fabric leaving seam allowance free around the edges .Quilt through if you wish or leave as is.
- Iron the wrong side of the quilted backing to the fusible side of the Stitch and Shape .Trim the curve at the top.
- Measure 8cm down from the top edge and draw a line.
- Place the top edge of the long strip face down along this line centering the strip evenly with the strip off the backing.
- Stitch down through fabric and Stitch and Shape.
- Flip the strip over and you should have a neat top edge
- Stitch again 6cm down from this line (on top of the first loop stitching.)
- Repeat until all loops have been stitched in place, finish lower edge by stitching down.
- Attach piping if desired.
- Place cord at top end or organiser and baste in place.
- Place other backing fabric, right sides together over the finished front and stitch around leaving an opening at the bottom to turn through.
- Turn through and slip stitch bottom opening.
- Store your stabilisers.
